You are birthing a New Day, and it is a messy, painful process. But soon your beautiful new 'child' -the Age of Peace- will be here, and the pain will be forgotten." Bahá'u'lláh affirms that the Divine Springtime has come. "Within the realms of holiness . . . a new garden hath appeared.
